

TRAPANI



PALERMO

CELAFU

This architectural marvel holds a prominent place within the UNESCO World Heritage Site known as Arab Norman Palermo, a collection of nine awe-inspiring structures. The sandy shores of Cefalu, graced by picturesque wooden rowing boats, provide an idyllic setting with the cathedral serving as a stunning backdrop—a true postcard-perfect scene.





ALICUDI & FILICUDI

Located at the western edge of the Aeolian archipelago, Alicudi captivates with its terraced slopes covered in lush fig trees, interspersed with striking black rock formations that carve narrow ravines, sloping valleys, and majestic cliffs, creating an awe-inspiring landscape that etches itself into memory. Filicudi harbors two intriguing archaeological sites dating back to the Bronze Age. The remarkable Blue Marino sea caves, accessible by boat, and the archaeological museum displaying salvaged artifacts from shipwrecks add to the island's allure.





SALINA

Salina, the verdant jewel of the Aeolian Islands, stands as the peak of fertility and natural splendor. Inhabited since ancient times, its name hails from the historical salt mining at the Lingua mine. Formed by six ancient volcanoes, Salina boasts the archipelago's highest peaks. Its unspoiled seabed teems with vibrant marine life, offering diving and snorkeling enthusiasts an unparalleled underwater adventure.





STROMBOLI

Nestled in the northeast, Stromboli presents a conical silhouette typical of a volcano. Its regular eruptions, often occurring several times per hour, create a mesmerizing spectacle visible even from afar, turning it into a captivating "lighthouse of the Mediterranean." Besides the exhilarating night hike to Stromboli's summit, visitors can also witness the awe-inspiring "Sciarra del Fuocco" - a cascading display of incandescent projections visible from the sea.





PANAREA

Immerse yourself in the sheer beauty of the island's most remarkable treasure, Cala Junco Bay, nestled at the southernmost tip of Panarea. LIPARI
